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What is the Brain Bus?

The Brain Bus provides Floridians a mobile command center which they can visit to become informed about the warning signs, benefits of early detections, steps to an accurate diagnosis, diagnostic centers in their community, and how to reduce risk through lifestyle changes.

We also support family caregivers by connecting them to local services and by educating about our 24/7 Helpline.

-  Training and education for caregivers
-  Targets underserved and rural areas

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How does the Brain Bus impact Floridians?

- Florida is at the epicenter of Alzheimer's disease with the second highest incident rate.
- The services of the Brain Bus are open to all individuals who need services, always free of charge.
- Additionally, all printed materials available on the Brain Bus are available in both English and Spanish versions.
- We have two Brain Bus vehicles: a Brain Van and a Brain RV. We have two drivers. One of our drivers speaks Spanish.

Brain Bus Contract to Date

- **300 Stops Planned**
 - **117** stops completed as of January 2020
 - **293** Stops scheduled as of February 2020 (this number includes completed stops)
- **2,000 Clients projected to be served**
 - **1,717** Clients served as of January 2020
- **48 Counties in Florida to be Visited**
 - **30** counties visited as of January 2020
